

PALERMO - EDIGA - CAT SANCTUARY

Franco Lannino manages the only cat sanctuary in Sicily. He looks after over 100 cats and works tirelessly to improve the welfare of cats. CASTEL VOLTURNO - LEGA PRO ANIMALE - SPAY AND NEUTER CENTRE - VARIOUS ANIMALS

PISA - GATTI MAMMONI - CAT SANCTUARY

Situated just outside of Pisa, it is managed by Tiziana Scognamiglio and cares for over 100 cats and for a number of colonies around the province of Pisa providing food and sterilisations. This year they would like your support in re-surfacing the soiled area in order to create a healthier and nicer environment for the cats.



COMO - ASSOCIATION CAVALLI DEL BISBINO - HORSES

Every year, in May the Bisbino horses leave their winter paddock to return to the green pastures high up on Mount Bisbino. Free to roam on the mountain during Spring and Summer, the lives of these horses are safeguarded by the Bisbino horses volunteers headed by veterinary Doctor Maria Chiara Lietti. The team are looking for support in refurbishing the feeding stations and would appreciate your contribution towards these.



CECINA - ASSOCIATION MICI FELICI - DOGS

Mici Felici was founded in March 2006 in Cecina by a group of volunteers who decided to join forces to rescue stray dogs and prevent animal abuse. This project is currently managing a small kennel that cares for 32 dogs. The group are in need of micro-chip readers to aid their work in helping so many stray animals on the coast of Tuscany.
